"In these times of Covid-19 pandemic, we decided to offer our Free plan for lifetime, if any user signs up in 2020. We would also be working with organizations and bigger Tech companies, to bring our unique and sustainable business model and deliver cashflow via positive unit economics into their existing lines of businesses," he added.

<u>NextLifeBook</u> will be targeting to be in 3 regional countries for 2020, and add Series A round of investors to scale the business globally.
